Following the closure of Jackson's Nursery where so many of us used to purchase our fuchsias, especially the more unusual fuchsias or new releases, we are considering arranging a system/scheme whereby our members look online, submit your request to nominated Committee member who will place a bulk order on behalf of the Society (i.e. bulk ordering, which may save on P&P). The specialist nursery which has been suggested is **Roualeyn Nurseries**. Many of us have purchased plants from this nursery, either direct or at the many RHS shows where they put on award-winning displays and sell fuchsias.

Roualeyn Nurseries do not produce a catalogue so members would need to view online.
